FIRST DRAFT – PUBLIC INPUT - SUMMARY

STATUS OF CODE DEVELOPMENT

- FIRST DRAFT MEETING HELD IN PHOENIX – MARCH 4TH AND 5TH
- 154 PUBLIC INPUTS WERE REVIEWED
- FIRST DRAFT BALLOT DUE IN AUGUST
- REPORT TO BE PUBLISHED BY NFPA THIS FALL
- 2ND DRAFT MEETING TENTATIVELY SCHEDULED FOR SPRING OF 2015
- NITMAM CLOSING DATE IS 8/21/15. or Fall of 2016

HIGHLIGHTS OF 1ST DRAFT MEETING

THESE PIs HAVE NOT BEEN THROUGH THE BALLOT PROCESS. ALL COMMENTS ARE BASED ON PRELIMINARY COMMITTEE CONCENSUS.

- MANY MINOR CHANGES (DEFINITIONS AND EDITORIAL)
- SERIES OF PROPOSALS TO CHANGE THE CURRENT THREE CLASSES OF STANDPIPES AND ELIMINATE WHAT WE CURRENTLY REFER TO AS CLASS I STANDPIPES. ALL RELATED PROPOSALS WERE REJECTED BY THE COMMITTEE.
- PROPOSAL TO ELIMINATE REQUIREMENT FOR INDICATING VALVES TO CONTROL BRANCHLINES (E.G., SINGLE FIRE HOSE VALVE) WAS REJECTED, BUT A HOSE VALVE LOCATED WITHIN 20 FEET OF THE STANDPIPE WOULD NOT REQUIRE A CONTROL VALVE.
- PROPOSAL TO ALLOW A SINGLE MULTIPLE STAGE, MULTIPORT FIRE PUMP TO SERVE MULTIPLE STANDPIPE ZONES WAS ACCEPTED. 30th 20 14

TO 750 GPM, AND FOR 13R BUILDINGS FROM 1250 GPM TO 1000 GPM WAS REJECTED.

- PROPOSAL TO CHANGE C FACTOR FOR GALVANIZED PIPE IN DRY STANDPIPES FROM 120 TO 100 WAS ACCEPTED.
- PROPOSAL TO ALLOW 5 PSI FLUCUATION DURING 2 HOUR HYDROSTATIC TEST WAS ACCPETED.
- PROPOSAL TO REQUIRE DRY MANUAL SYSTEMS TO BE MONITORED WITH AIR WAS ACCEPTED (PREVIOUS EDITIONS ONLY REQUIRED MONITORING OF SYSTEMS WITH CONCEALED PIPE).
- PROPOSAL TO LIMIT FHV TRAVEL DISTANCE IN OPEN PARKING GARAGES TO 130 FT WAS ACCEPTED.
Comply with International building Code
